### About the role

### Job Description

#### ROLE AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Studies include assessments of job creation and inclusive economic growth, access to essential services in low-income countries, gender-focused investing, carbon emissions reporting and capital market development.
- Support the development of sector strategies by providing research and analytical input into guidance designed to maximise the impact of PIDG Company interventions.
- Advise and support investment teams on impact and measurement during the investment process, from initiation to annual reporting and evaluations.
- Ensure PIDG compliance with IATI reporting standards
- Provide quality assurance on studies produced by consultants
- Support the implementation of frameworks and KPIs on PIDG impact priorities, including on gender, affordability of services to low-income populations, financial and non-financial additionality
