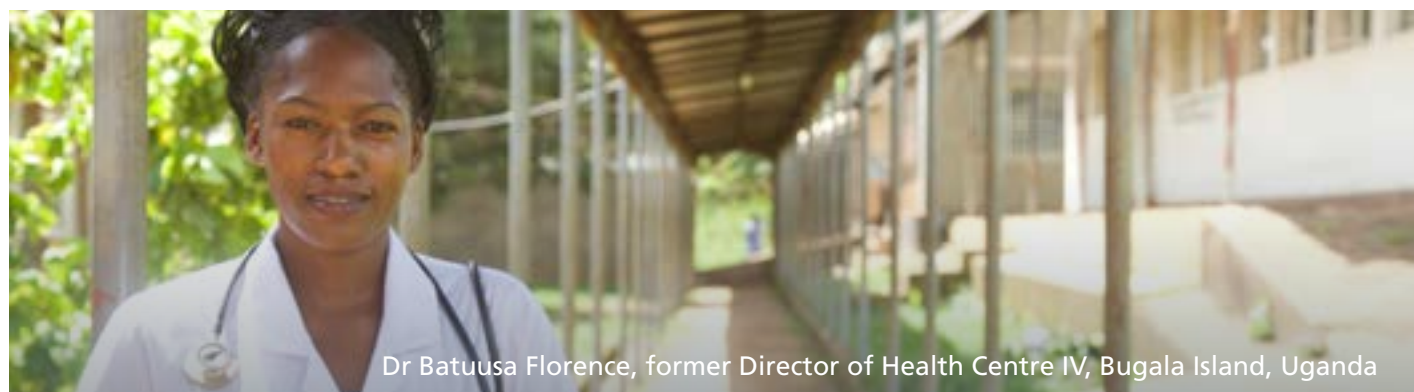

Project round-up

These are just some of the project initiatives we have actioned through the PIDG-wide COVID-response task team



Kalangala Infrastructure Services, Uganda

To enable safe operations to Infrastructure Services' ferry route in Uganda, ferries are being deep cleaned after every journey and passengers have access to

handwashing stations and medical checks before boarding.

Zambia, Underpinning Covid-19 preparedness with access to clean power

Infraco Africa, supported by TA - at Western Power in Zambia - are supporting delivery of clean water for the school and health post as well as PPE and awareness raising efforts.

Bonergie, water, Senegal

USD15,000 raised to support for 6 health centres serving 150 households with solar PV kits, face shields, PPE and face masks.



Philippines smart solar network

InfraCo Asia continues to provide a subsidy on energy bills for all end users of its Philippines Smart Solar Network project in order to help the off-grid community tide through a difficult time where precautionary self-isolation has cut off access to the usual channels of income.

InfraCo Asia in Myanmar – TA grant for vital PPE:

InfraCo Asia, with funding from PIDG's Technical Assistance, and its contracted developer team ICM, is supplying vital personal protective equipment (PPE) to key distribution nodes supporting COVID-19 response efforts in Myanmar. This included a donation of surgical masks, isolation gowns and KN95 masks to Waibargi Hospital, a healthcare facility specialising in infectious disease control.



Quantum Terminals, gas storage, Ghana

USD100,000 has been raised for sanitary items for seven community hospitals, including face masks and solid washing soap for the community, hand sanitizers, buckets and face masks for the project.

Nyumba Ya Akiba Cement, Congo (D.R.)

USD50,000 has been raised for sanitary kits and masks for 600 families in the project's local community.



GuarantCo and PIDG TA support to Kacific and Acorn

The innovative student accommodation provider Acorn continues to operate 3 building sites in Kenya with extra protective measures, providing vital income for hundreds of students and the company plans going. We are sharing the company's additional costs through a PIDG TA grant.



Classic Fashion Jordan

A TA grant of USD100,000 has been approved for Classic Fashion in Jordan, to support additional costs of complying with COVID-related H&S rules in factories and hostels.

Mixta, social housing, Nigeria

USD49,716 has been raised to sanitise booths and PPE equipment at construction sites.
